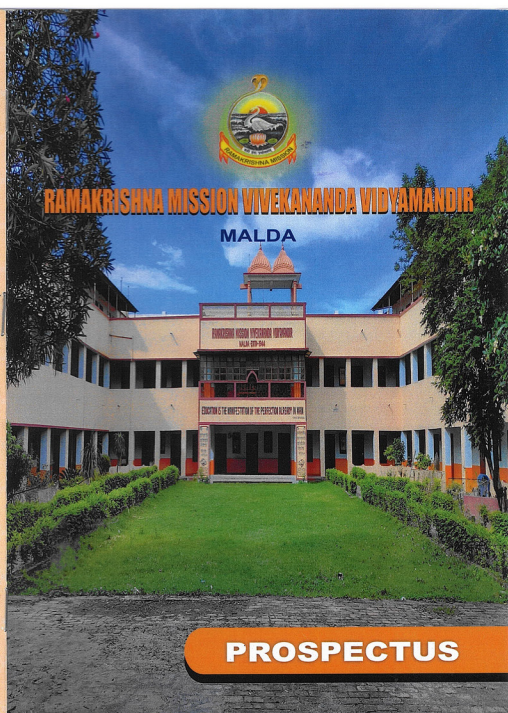

RAMAKRISHNA MISSION VIVEKANANDA VIDYAMANDIR MALDA

The aim of Vidyamandir, run by Ramakrishna Mission, is to make students enlightened citizens with strong moral background. Since 1944, this Vidyamandir has been playing a great role in spreading education in our locality. Along with education, good behavior, morality, discipline is also most important in students' life. These will help them to become a complete man in future. So, following norms (behavioural and institutional) are framed in our school. Every student should abide by these rules and regulations.

- 'শ্রদ্ধাবান্ধন লভতে জ্ঞানম্' - remembering it, every student should maintain humble behaviour.
- 'ছাত্রাগামধ্যয়নং তপস্' - study is an austerity. Regular study should be the chief aim of every student.
- It is compulsory for every student to take part in school assembly at 10-45 am every day before starting school activity. During prayer time, students should maintain calm and quiet atmosphere.
- Every student should come to school in proper school dress (school badge should be stitched with it). Id card and school record book must be with every student. Students should cut their hair and nail short in size. Otherwise, no permission is given to them to enter the classroom.
- 'Cleanliness is next to Godliness' - it is the duty of every student to maintain the cleanliness of School premises and their classrooms. Any writing, drawing on walls are punishable. Always use dustbin for throwing out papers, packets, etc.

- Every student should maintain discipline in school campus and in their classroom. They should abide by the instructions of the teachers. Respectful attitude towards teachers is essential for every student, otherwise it is considered to be a merciless offence. If any student engages himself in any unfair activity – oppose to the ideal of Vidyamandir – he may be expelled from the school. So, good and humble behaviour is essential for every student.

- Students should not go outside from their classrooms except in tiffin time. Running here and there, making noise, speaking loudly are strictly prohibited. Before last bell of the school, no student can go outside from the school without the permission of Headmaster Maharaj.

- Every student should participate in educational and cultural programmes in school.

- It is compulsory for every student to attend the school programmes for celebrating foundation day, Swamiji's Birthday, Netaji's birth day, Republic day, Tagore's birth day, independence day, etc. Also it is compulsory to attend annual prize giving ceremony.

- Parents are cordially invited to all the programmes of Vidyamandir.

- If necessary, it is compulsory for our students to participate in any relief work conducted by Ramakrishna Mission.

- Students are not allowed to bring mobile phone, wrist watch or any costly material in the school. These are strictly prohibited.

- Students are awarded on the basis of viz., results of annual exam, performance in annual sports, good conduct, regularity (full attendance) and also special performance in any activity.

- Any unfair activity of the student during examination (copying, talking with others, talking in bathroom, etc.) is liable to cancel his all exams. So, students should have to maintain proper environment in exam. hall.

- Telling slang words and stealing are strictly prohibited. If it is found that any student is repeatedly doing these, he may be expelled from the school.

- Being a miniature of society, our school seeks the students to be active to learn group living. Cheerfulness, co-operation, fellow-feeling and amity should be in them. They must also be inquisitive in nature.

SCHOOL DRESS :

Every student should come to school in proper school dress. For students of class V to VII: navy blue half pant, white shirt and white cadet with navy blue socks. For class VIII to X: navy blue full pant, white shirt and white cadet with navy blue socks. School identity card is also an essential part of the dress. In winter season, navy blue full pant and white full shirt with navy blue woolen sweater are the dress of all students from class V to X. For higher secondary students: white shirt, white full pant and white cadet with white socks are required. Uniform should be neat and clean. Otherwise, students are not allowed to enter the school.

Regulations regarding presence and absence of students in school :

Every student should be present in school every day. For any absence of students, guardian should write the proper reason of it in school record book and sign it. Students should show this record book to the class teacher and Headmaster Maharaj when he will come to school after absence. If a student is absent for consecutive three days for his illness then, application with medical certificate must be submitted to the HM Maharaj through class teacher. In case of absence for long period, it is necessary to take prior permission from HM Maharaj. Every student should have to enter school before the assembly. Generally late present in school is not allowed.

Regulations regarding Examinations :

- In every session there are three exams. – commenced 1st Terminal (2nd week of April), 2nd Terminal (1st week of August) and Final Exam (last week of November). It is compulsory to appear in all these exams. On the basis of total marks obtained in these three exams, the final result is determined. If it is not possible for any student to appear in the exam for his serious illness or any other serious reason, then prior intimation should be given to HM Maharaj. In this case the final result is determined on the basis of results in other Terminal exams.

- The subject- Indian Culture, is a compulsory subject from Class V to IX. Minimum 30% marks must be obtained in this subject.
- For appearing in any examination 80% attendance before that examination must be required. If less than that, no student is allowed to appear before the exam.
- Minimum 30% marks should be obtained in every subject. The students who will fail in the class, he will not be allowed to continue his study in this school.
